- C. Wardens
 - Senior Warden: Parish Life seems to be recovering: there have been funeral receptions as well as the Marini baptismal celebration; Lessons and Carols is coming up
 - O Junior Warden:
 - Meeting soon with the Nominations Committee seeking candidates for vestry and diocesan convention representative
 - Ad hoc Budget Committee is coming together; first meeting will be between Thanksgiving and Christmas
